

Special Autodesk Award

This year, as a special feature of the AFSF High School Design Competition, the Autodesk Corporation is sponsoring a special award for students who design their project using Autodesk Revit Architecture software. Winners of this category will receive separate awards. To qualify for this award, students must:

- Complete all High School Design Competition design work using Autodesk Revit Architecture software
- Use print outs from Revit Architecture in their final presentation boards.
- Submit a mounted 8 ½ x 11” 3D Perspective rendering of their model and a CD disk containing their final Revit Architecture Files, including all plan views and levels, elevations, 3D perspectives, rendered files and at least one camera walk through of the building.

Submission: CD files should be submitted with the final presentation boards and models on the day of entry into the contest. CD's must be clearly marked with student name and school.

Software Availability: Students may download a free copy of Autodesk Revit Architecture 2009 at <http://students.autodesk.com>

Training: The Architectural Foundation of San Francisco will provide a one day introductory training in Autodesk Revit Architecture 2009 for teachers and students on February 7, 2009 at the Build San Francisco Institute, 706 Mission Street -- Suite 500.
