

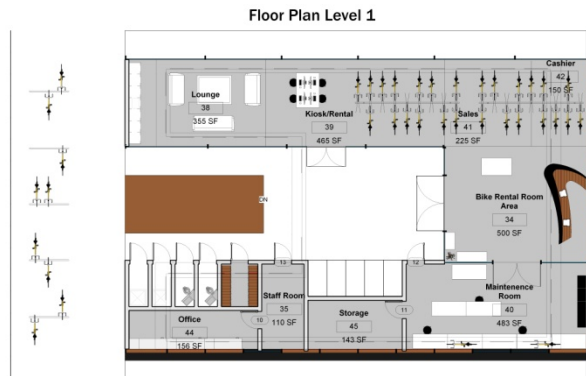

What Is Build San Francisco?

The Build San Francisco Institute meets from 1:00 pm – 3:30 pm, 5 days a week. Each afternoon, students join instructors in a real architecture studio to work on real projects centered in the development of a major San Francisco construction project.

Three afternoons each week students will earn academic credit in two classes: Environmental Science (U.C. "G" elective credit); and Architecture and Design (U.C. "F" visual arts credit). Two afternoons each week the students will meet with professionals in the fields of architecture, design, construction or urban planning who will serve as mentors on a one-to-one basis with each of the students. All credits will be granted through their regular school, and count towards high school graduation. Classes are held in the Build San Francisco Design Studio located at 901 Mission Street.



Who Should Apply? The Build San Francisco Institute is open to any San Francisco high school student aged 16 or older in good academic standing at his or her own high school.

Students with an interest in design, architecture, government, sociology, law, environmental studies, construction or engineering will all benefit. Interested students make continue the program through their senior year.
