

PORTFOLIO WORKSHOP

Are you thinking of applying to architecture school but wondering how to put together a portfolio? If the answer is yes, then join us for our AFSF Virtual Portfolio Workshop. We're offering (2) Saturday sessions; you can join us for a single session OR attend both. The goal is for you to have an opportunity to ask questions, hear more about what a portfolio is all about, share some of the work/projects you're including in your portfolio, and get feedback & critique from the workshop instructor as well as peers in the studio.

- **Workshop:** in the virtual workshop, you'll meet with our AFSF architecture studio instructor and talk through specific ideas and strategies for your portfolio. This will be a working session where you can get feedback, critique, and recommendations for next steps in creating a portfolio of your work.

When is the workshop?

Can I attend just one of the Saturday workshops?

Yes, you can register and attend either of the workshops.

Can I attend both of the Saturday workshops?

Yes, you can register for both workshops. We'll cover the same information at the start of both workshops, but the idea is that this is an opportunity for you to ask questions, share your ideas & current work and you may want additional time beyond just one workshop. You might even want to work on your in-progress portfolio after the first workshop and bring your additional, revised, and/or new work to the second workshop.

Who should take the Portfolio Workshop?

It's open to high school students who are considering or planning to apply to an undergraduate architecture & design program.

What if I've already graduated from high and considering applying to a bachelor of architecture program or switching majors in my current school?

Yes, this workshop is open to you!

What if I'm planning to submit a portfolio this year for Fall 2024?

You may already be close to finishing your portfolio or maybe you have completed it. This is an opportunity to get any final feedback before you submit.

What if I'm at the very beginning of my portfolio process?

Being at the beginning is a great place to be! If you're thinking about applying in 1-2 years, this workshop will offer insight & strategies for building your portfolio.

What if I don't have any "finished architectural" projects in my portfolio?

That's ok. A portfolio to a B.Arch/Bachelor of Architecture program may include architectural

projects but it's definitely not a requirement. Portfolios to a B.Arch program include creative work in other disciplines and media. Remember: you're applying to a school of architecture to learn about being an architect/designer. An admissions dept doesn't expect you to already be an architect with a portfolio filled with building projects. Your portfolio is about sharing and demonstrating your creative work and illustrating how you think as a designer. So the work you include can be broad and represent other creative disciplines and media.
